


## ***Hidden Figures* Film Discussion on Zoom October 11-7:00PM and October 13-1:00PM**

### **Join the Discussion of the Film *HIDDEN FIGURES***

Concerned about racism? Want to join in the conversation about it? There are two opportunities to discuss the acclaimed film about a team of female African American mathematicians (called back then “Computers”) who served an important role in NASA during the early years of the U.S. space program—**Tuesday, Oct. 11, at 7 PM; and Thursday, Oct. 13 at 1 PM via Zoom.**

Starring Taraji P. Henson as Katherine Goble Johnson, Octavia Spencer as Dorothy Vaughan, Janelle Monáe as Mary Jackson, and Kevin Costner as Al Harrison, their project manager, the film depicts well the prejudice against them in 1962, both as women and as women of color. A tale of pluck and perseverance, it is a truly “feel good” movie suitable for family viewing. Participants are encouraged to share experiences of their own workplaces in regard to inter-racial hiring.

Of interest to Presbytery members is that our Pat Meadows, Co-Chair of our Committee on Representation & Diversity attended the same college as Katherine Johnston, West Virginia State University.

Our local film critic Edward McNulty will lead the discussion and has prepared a discussion guide available from the Presbytery’s website.
