Our mission elder along with her committee purchase the food, organize it, make up boxes, and distribute the food. We are grateful to the Network Support and Grant Committee of our Presbytery for the seed money to begin this valuable and needed endeavor in Seven Mile. A few farmers in the area contribute vegetables for the food boxes during summer months. This truly helps those families with many children who do not receive help when school is out. Since the cost of food, as well as rent, utilities, and gas, have gone up so drastically we are seeing an increased need for this service in the Village.
