# MINUTES OF THE PRESBYTERY OF THE MIAMI VALLEY STATED MEETING, SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 12, 2022 ZOOM HOSTED BY SEVEN MILE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH 9:00 AM

#### **PREPARE**

#### **OPENING OF THE STATED MEETING**

The meeting was convened at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, November 12, 2022, by Minister of Word and Sacrament Sarah Sparks-Franklin, Moderator, who opened with prayer. Moderator shared a that Minutes for Good News could be shared in the chat for everyone to read and gave instructions for voting and joining breakout rooms on Zoom.

The moderator then welcomed first time commissioners to the meeting and called on COM vice-chair, MWS Anna Owens to introduce new pastors, MWS Annie Melick, Eaton, and to offer a memorial for MWS David Girbert, HR, who joined the Church Triumphant. (Appendix C)

#### STATEMENT OF QUORUM AND EXCUSED ABSENCES

Moderator Sparks-Franklin declared that a quorum was present, and that the formation of the roll was formed by advance registration of presbyters and confirmed those registered present electronically by observation of their faces and names on Zoom and the participants list. APPROVAL OF THE DOCKET

**A motion prevailed** to adopt the agenda with no changes.

**WORSHIP** was led by MWS Sarah Sparks-Franklin. The sermon from MWS Mihee Kim-Kort was based on Acts 4:5-12. MWS Carol Pierson presided at communion.

#### HOSPITALITY REPORT

CRE Gidget Collins, pastor of Seven Mile Presbyterian Church, shared video about the church. She also shared the mission by inviting those present to support the food pantry that they host at the church. She then led the Land Acknowledgement.

#### **BREAKOUT SESSION: Hearing Heats: Learning to Listen**

MWS Amy Duiker introduced this session and Deacon Bryce Wiebe invited those present to share who had taught them to pray. He also encouraged everyone to consider what you

experienced and what you expected. Each person was to share for 2 minutes and the other person in your group was to simply listen.

#### REPORT OF THE STATED CLERK

MWS Lynn Bova, Stated Clerk, thanked all of the congregations who offer support through their offerings and per capita payments. She reported that the Minutes for the September 13, 2022, meeting and other Administrative Commissions to install were to be approved in the consent agenda. She shared correspondence that was received from PILP and Special Offerings and thanked all the congregations who support any or all of the Special Offerings.

The stated clerk gave a report on the reading of the 2020 and 2021 Minutes. She reported that the following churches had not completed their minute review: Blue Ball (scheduled for Nov. 14), Immanuel Korean, Huntsville, Jamestown, Middletown, St. Luke, Rushsylvania, West Liberty, and Yellow Springs (it appears they have been read but no report was filed).

The stated clerk reminded everyone that statistical season is here and that she has contacted the clerks of sessions and has a meeting set up for November 30 to answer questions. The portal opens on December 2 for churches.

The stated clerk reported that there are about 33 proposed changes to the book of order including a totally rewritten section called Church Discipline (currently the Book of Discipline). Meetings will be held on Zoom to discuss the changes over the next few months before voting takes place. GA Actions and the proposed amendments to the Constitution were made available. The stated clerk reminded commissioners to be sure all staff including treasurers had the new presbytery address and that the upcoming the upcoming 2023 Presbytery Meeting dates with planned locations:

In my opinion, the financial statements referred to above present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of Presbytery of the Miami Valley as of December 31, 2021, and the changes in its net assets and its cash flows for the year then ended in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

#### **Received the report of the Leadership Council:**

- 1. Approved an amount not to exceed \$1500 be taken from the Church Sale Money Market fund (330.200) for treasurers' training.
- 2. Approved an amount not to exceed \$8000 taken from the Church Sale Money Market fund (330.200) for an Enneagram workshop, cohort groups and assessments.
- 3. Approved an honorarium of \$200 for MWS Mihee Kim-Kort for preaching at the presbytery meeting coming from Presbytery Meetings (501.425)
- 4. Approved the food pantry at the Seven Mile Presbyterian Church as our mission at every meeting for November's Presbytery meeting.
- 5. Approved pulling \$5000 from the COM line item 501.200 and \$4500 from Committee on Representation and Diversity line item 501.204 in the proposed budget for 2023 and taking those amounts from the church sale money market fund (330.200).

- 6. Approved recommending the renewal of Executive Presbyter Terry Kukuk's call for another 5 year term beginning on March 1, 2023.
- 7. Approved recommending the amended proposed budget including the terms of call for the EP and SC go to Presbytery for approval.

Isaacs, following the congregational meeting on Sunday, October 30, to be effective November 4, 2022. The final dissolution papers will be signed and provided following the congregational meeting.
  - (2.) Agreed to transfer Rev. Isaacs to the member-at-large roll of this presbytery effective November 4, 2022.
  - (3.) In conjunction with the end of this pastoral call, and the congregation's concurrence thereof, the Presbytery of the Miami Valley, through its Committee on Ministry, agrees to:
  - a. Provide pastoral care to all parties involved and hold all parties involved in prayer.

- b. Appoint a Moderator for the Session and provide it with support and assistance as appropriate.
- c. Provide the Session with assistance in securing ongoing pastoral leadership.
- d. Comply in all respects with the PCUSA Standards of Ethical Conduct Life Together in a Community of Faith: Standards of Ethical Conduct for Ordained Officers in the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) as attached.
- e. Monitor compliance with this agreement and enforce breaches of this agreement as described above in items 2d and 3d.
- 4. Authorized the COM chair in consultation with the Executive Presbyter and Vice Chair of COM to appoint a moderator for Middletown to be ratified at the November COM meeting.
- 5. Appointed a team including MWS Anna Owens (liaison), RE Bridget Hawkins, RE Michael Seewer (in an advisory role), RE Alice McCollum, and MWS Lynn Bova (staff) to walk with the session and pastor to address reported irregularities and discord at College Hill Community Church.
- 6. Approved the updated pulpit supply list.

## **Leadership Council**

**MWS** Lawrence Bartel brought a recommendation from the Staff Support committee following EP Terry Kukuk's review. A motion prevailed to renew the contract for the Executive Presbyter, MWS Terry Kukuk, for an additional 5 years beginning March 1, 2023.

A motion prevailed to approve the 2023 Budget including the terms of call for EP Terry Kukuk and SC Lynn Bova.

**A motion prevailed** to change the PMV Bylaws Section 2.02 and 2.03 to read as follows (a first reading was done in September):

#### Section 2.02: Representatives of Churches

Each session under the jurisdiction of the presbytery shall be represented at each meeting of the presbytery by the number of ruling elders directed by the following active membership calculations:

1 - 249 members:250 or more members:2 ruling elder2 ruling elders

Whenever a session is not represented by a regularly elected ruling elder commissioner at four consecutive Stated Meetings without excuses satisfactory to the presbytery, the session shall be notified in writing by the Stated Clerk and shall be requested to render satisfactory reason for this absence.

#### Section 2.03: Ruling Elder Members of the Presbytery

Ruling elders elected to serve as: Moderator, Vice-Moderator, Leadership Council Chair, a member of the Leadership Council, a member of the Committee on Ministry, a member of the Committee on Preparation for Ministry, a chairperson of a standing committee, Executive

Presbyter, and Stated Clerk shall be enrolled as ruling elder members of the presbytery for the duration of service in these positions, whether or not commissioned by their sessions.

#### **COMMITTEE ON MINISTRY**

# Anna Owens, Vice Chair, reported and brought the following motion from the COM:

The Committee on Ministry of the Presbytery of Miami Valley recommends that the Presbytery of Miami Valley appoint an Administrative Commission for College Hill Community Presbyterian Church as described below.

## + PC(USA) Book of Order, G-3.0109 b (5), Administrative Commissions:

Administrative commissions are designated to consider and conclude matters not involving ecclesiastical judicial process, except that in the discharge of their assigned responsibilities they may discover and report to the designating council matters that may require judicial action by the council.

Functions that may be entrusted to administrative commissions include, but are not limited to:

(5) (by presbyteries, synods, and the General Assembly) visiting particular councils, congregations, or agencies over which they have immediate jurisdiction reported to be affected with disorder, and inquiring into and settling the difficulties therein, except that no commission of a presbytery shall be empowered to dissolve a pastoral relationship without the specific authorization by the designating body (G-2.0901).

#### **Background or Report of Disorder**

The Committee on Ministry has become aware of serious, unresolved conflicts within College Hill Community Presbyterian Church that are endangering the life and ministry of the congregation. As such, the Committee on Ministry is reporting to the Presbytery that the congregation is affected with disorder.

A variety of serious difficulties associated with church leadership at College Hill have been reported to the Committee on Ministry, specifically relating to the Session and the Pastor/Moderator. These problems have been enumerated by a substantial number of questions and complaints from a significant number of individuals, as well as requests for presbytery assistance by these individuals. Many of these individuals are ordained Ruling Elders and Deacons who have called, emailed, and written letters to the Committee on Ministry.

To list a few of these concerns:

1. The Session has closed itself off from the congregation, refusing requests for attendance at meetings, and leaving correspondence to the Session from concerned members unanswered. Though closing Session meetings is technically permitted per Robert's Rules of Order, it must be done by formal vote of the Session and recorded in the Session meetings. As of this writing, the Committee on Ministry has no confirmation that this vote was taken. Additionally, a non-Presbyterian pastor, who is not an installed member of the Session, has voice. This, too, must be done by formal vote of the Session, and, again, as of this writing, there is no evidence that this vote has taken place. (G-3.0107/G-3.0201)

- 2. Members of the congregation have been removed from congregational meetings, Session meetings, and committee meetings by the pastor and the Session due to disagreements over membership, policy, and practice. This does not follow the process outlined in the Rules of Discipline. (D-1.0103)
- 3. Congregational meetings (G-1.05) have been conducted in a manner not in line with the Book of Order's requirements for decency and order to be maintained. Specifically, a member stood up to address concerns about the pastor and the Session, and her membership was publicly questioned by the pastor and Session, who conferred together and claimed this member was, in fact, not in active membership status and requested that she leave the meeting. The person in question was a member, and no public acknowledgment or apology was ever made. This information should have been readily available from the clerk of session "...shall keep its rolls of membership and attendance, maintain any required registers... (G-3.0204, see also G-3.0204a Membership Roll)
- 4. Requests for recordings of congregational meetings have been refused to people who were in attendance. In consultation with the denomination, it has been stated that recordings become part of the official record and the bylaws should reflect how electronic meetings are held and who has access to and if a motion to record is required. No request to record appears to have been made.
- 5. Non-members have been baptized, despite expressing limited interest in becoming members. While this is technically allowed per our polity, there is no record that the Session approved these baptisms following the instructions in the Book of Order (W-3.0403).
- 6. The pastor has assumed the responsibility of chairing committees. This practice does not seem to uphold the Bylaws of College Hill Community Church stating that "the lead officer of all organizations, ministering units, committees and task forces shall be an active member or friend of the congregation." The pastor holds membership in the Presbytery.
- 7. An installed elder was removed from a Session meeting and received a formal letter dictating that she not participate in further committee meetings until conflict resolution process had been observed. This process, as well as the removal of an installed elder, does not follow the Book of Discipline's process for removing an installed elder. Additionally, this decision was made in a called Session meeting that changed the purpose of the meeting without notifying all members prior to the meeting. (G-3.0203)
- 8. The pastor and Session have arranged votes regarding moving the pastor's status from Stated Supply to Installed. This has been done without authority from the Committee on Ministry and does not follow the Presbytery's requirements for this to take place (Presbytery of the Miami Valley Policy and Practice Handbook, Committee on Ministry, practice 2.04)
- 9. The Clerk of Session has failed to keep appropriate records for Session meetings and Congregational meetings, which violates the BoO (G-3.0104 and G-3.0204 and G-3.0107).
- 10. The Session and the pastor asked the Committee on Ministry for an exemption to electing elders in 2021, though it has been stated that there was a slate of elders prepared by the nominating committee for that year.

These are only a few of the many expressions of concern that have come to the attention of the Committee on Ministry of the Presbytery of the Miami Valley. Collectively, they reflect serious dysfunction.

#### Purpose:

The Committee on Ministry recommends pursuant to the Book of Order provisions G-3.0109b (5) that the Presbytery authorize the Moderator to appoint an Administrative Commission to work with College Hill Community Presbyterian Church. The Commission will consist of five (5) presbyters, at least one of whom shall be a member of the Committee on Ministry, with the remaining members representing an even distribution of teaching and ruling elders from churches in the Presbytery of the Miami Valley, for the following purposes, including but not limited to:

- a. Working with the Session, Pastor, and congregation to address the causes of division and disorder, and to seek ways to encourage constructive resolution on the issues;
- b. Working with the Session, Pastor, and congregation in addressing issues of relationships and expectations among pastor, officers, staff, and members;
- c. Providing at least two (2) persons of the Administrative Commission to attend all Session meetings with voice (but no vote) and to provide leadership where necessary and appropriate;
- d. Reporting its progress to the Committee on Ministry monthly,
- e. Providing an initial report of its findings and recommendations to the Presbytery of the Miami Valley at the next immediate stated meeting following its appointment; and
- f. Providing regular reports to the presbytery thereafter until completion.

#### Scope and Authority

It is further recommended that this Administrative Commission have the full authority of Presbytery of the Miami Valley in addressing this matter with the congregation., except where limited by the Presbyterian Church (USA)'s Book of Order. If it is determined by the Administrative Commission that the Session of College Hill Community Presbyterian Church in Dayton, Ohio cannot exercise its authority, or is unable or unwilling to manage wisely its affairs, the Administrative Commission of the Presbytery of the Miami Valley, after a thorough investigation and a full opportunity to be heard is given to all parties involved, has the authority to assume original jurisdiction with full powers of the Session, in which case the Session of the College Hill Community Presbyterian Church will cease to act until such time as the Presbytery shall otherwise direct (G-3.0303e).

The Moderator of the Presbytery is to appoint the members according to our bylaws Article VI, Section 6.02.

# A motion to amend as follows prevailed:

#### + PC(USA) Book of Order, G-3.0109 b (5), Administrative Commissions:

Administrative commissions are designated to consider and conclude matters not involving ecclesiastical judicial process, except that in the discharge of their assigned responsibilities they may discover and report to the designating council matters that may require judicial action by the council.

#### **Background or Report of Disorder**

The Committee on Ministry has become aware of serious, unresolved conflicts within College Hill Community Presbyterian Church that are endangering the life and ministry of the congregation. As such, the Committee on Ministry is reporting to the Presbytery that the congregation is affected with disorder.

#### Purpose:

The Committee on Ministry recommends pursuant to the Book of Order provisions G-3.0109b (5) that the Presbytery authorize the Moderator to appoint an Administrative Commission to work with College Hill Community Presbyterian Church. The Commission will consist of five (5) presbyters, at least one of whom shall be a member of the Committee on Ministry, with the remaining members representing an even distribution of teaching and ruling elders from churches in the Presbytery of the Miami Valley, for the following purposes, including but not limited to:

- a. Working with the Session, Pastor, and congregation to address the causes of division and disorder, and to seek ways to encourage constructive resolution on the issues,
- b. Working with the Session, Pastor, and congregation in addressing issues of relationships and expectations among pastor, officers, staff, and members,
- c. Providing at least two (2) persons of the Administrative Commission to attend all Session meetings with voice (but no vote) and to provide leadership where necessary and appropriate,
- d. Reporting its progress to the Committee on Ministry monthly,
- e. Providing an initial report of its findings and recommendations to the Presbytery of the Miami Valley at the next immediate stated meeting following its appointment; and
- f. Providing regular reports to the presbytery thereafter until completion.

#### **Scope** and Authority

It is further recommended that this Administrative Commission have the full authority of Presbytery of the Miami Valley in addressing this matter with the congregation., except where limited by the Presbyterian Church (USA)'s Book of Order. If it is determined by the Administrative Commission that the Session of College Hill Community Presbyterian Church in Dayton, Ohio cannot exercise its authority, or is unable or unwilling to manage wisely its affairs, the Administrative Commission of the Presbytery of the Miami Valley, after a thorough investigation and a full opportunity to be heard is given to all parties involved, has the authority to assume original jurisdiction with full powers of the Session, in which case the Session of the College Hill Community Presbyterian Church will cease to act until such time as the Presbytery shall otherwise direct (G-3.0303e).

The Moderator of the Presbytery is to appoint the members according to our bylaws Article VI, Section 6.02.

A motion was made, seconded and prevailed to table this motion until the next presbytery meeting. College Hill requested time to work on issues internally and to meet with a group from COM.

The moderator closed this time with prayer.



# Rev. David Allen Girbert June 1, 1938 – September 25, 2022

Rev. David A. Girbert,84, of Springfield, passed away September 25, 2022, in Springfield Regional Medical Center. #### Independent Auditor's Report

To the Board of Trustees of Presbytery of the Miami Valley Dayton, Ohio

#### Opinion

I have audited the accompanying financial statements of Presbytery of the Miami Valley (a nonprofit organization), which comprise the statement of financial position as of December 31, 2021, and related statements of activities, functional expenses, and cash flows for the year then ended, and the related notes to the financial statements.

In my opinion, the financial statements referred to above present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of Presbytery of the Miami Valley as of December 31, 2021, and the changes in its net assets and its cash flows for the year then ended in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

#### **Basis for Opinion**

I conducted my audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. My responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements of my report. Notes to Financial Statements

Year Ended December 31, 2021

- 1. NATURE OF OPERATIONS: Presbytery of the Miami Valley (the "Organization") is a not-for-profit corporation. The Organization's mission is to receive, hold, and transfer property of the Miami Presbytery of the Presbyterian Church in the United States. The Organization receives the majority of its funding from program service income, contributions and grants, and interest.
- **2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES:** The following accounting principles and practices of the Organization are set forth to facilitate the understanding of data presented in the financial statements.

**Method of accounting**— The accompanying financial statements have been prepared on the accrual basis of accounting in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America for not-for-profit organizations.

**Basis of presentation**—The Organization reports information regarding its financial position and activities according to two classes of net assets: net assets with donor restrictions and net assets without donor restrictions. A description of each class as it pertains to the Organization is as follows:

Net Assets With Donor Restrictions—Net assets subject to donor (or certain grantor) imposed restrictions. Some donor imposed restrictions are temporary in nature, such as those that will be met by the passage of time or other events specified by the donor. Other donor imposed restrictions are perpetual in nature, where the donor stipulates that resources be maintained in perpetuity. Donor imposed restrictions are released when a restriction expires, that is, when the stipulated time has elapsed, when the stipulated purpose for which the resource was restricted has been fulfilled, or both.

Net Assets Without Donor Restrictions—Net assets available for use in general operations and not subject to donor (or certain grantor) restrictions.

**Functional allocation of expenses**—The costs of providing the various programs and other activities have been summarized on a functional basis in the statements of functional expenses. Accordingly, certain costs have been allocated among the programs and supporting services benefited.

**Contributions**—The Organization records contributions received as unrestricted, temporarily restricted, or permanently restricted support depending on the existence and/or nature of any donor restrictions. Contributions that are restricted by the donor are reported as increases in unrestricted net assets in unrestricted net assets if the restrictions expire in the year in which the contributions are received.

Cash and cash equivalents—Interest-bearing deposits and short-term investment with original maturities of three months or less are classified as cash equivalents. Periodically during the year, the Organization has cash deposits in excess of federally insured limits. The Organization has not experienced any losses in such accounts and believes it is not exposed to any significant credit risk with its cash on deposit with financial institution.

**Investments**—The Organization's investments are stated at fair value. Fair value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participation at the measurement date. See Note 5 for discussion of fair value measurements.

Unrealized gain or loss includes the Organization's gains or losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the year. The Organization's investments are subject to the normal risks associated with financial markets.

**Property and equipment**—Property and equipment are stated at cost (fair value at date of donation for donated assets) and depreciated over their estimated useful lives using the straight-line method. Expenditures for maintenance and repairs are charged to expense when incurred.

The Organization maintains a policy to not depreciate its equipment and collection of books.

**Notes receivable**—Notes receivable consist of various loans to entities within the Miami Presbytery of the Presbyterian Church in the United States. Income earned from these loans is included in interest.

**Income taxes**—The Organization qualifies as a tax-exempt, nonprofit organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Accordingly, no provision for federal income tax is required. Management does not believe that the Organization conducts any activities subject to taxation as unrelated business income. In addition, management concluded that there are no uncertain tax positions and, accordingly, there is no adjustment to the financial statements.

With few exceptions, the Organization's federal information returns are no longer subject to examination by the Internal Revenue Service for the years before 2018.

**Use of estimates**—The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require the Organization to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amount and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results could differ from those estimates.

**3. LIQUIDITY AND AVAILABILITY:** The following reflects the Organization's financial assets as of December 31, 2021, reduced by amounts not available for general use because of contractual or donor-imposed restrictions within one year.

The Organization is substantially supported by contributions, which may contain donor restrictions. Because a donor's restriction requires resources to be used in a particular manner or in a future period, the Organization must maintain sufficient resources to meet those responsibilities. Consequently, financial assets may not be available for general expenditure within one year. As part of the Organization's liquidity management, it has a policy to structure its financial assets to be available as its general expenditures, liabilities, and other obligations become due. It is the policy of the Organization to regularly review and assess the need for funds to meet operating obligations and to ensure the availability of cash or collateral to fulfill those requirements.

**4. INVESTMENTS:** Investments at December 31, 2021 consisted of mutual funds with a fair market value of \$1,347,997 and an estimated cost of \$994,441.

Interest earned on investments totaled \$57,139 for the year ended December 31, 2021.

- 5. FAIR VALUE MEASUREMENTS: The Organization applies accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America (GAAP) for fair value measurements of financial assets that are recognized or disclosed at fair value in the financial statements on a recurring basis. Fair value is defined as the price that would be received for an asset or paid to transfer a liability, in the principal or most advantageous market for the asset or liability, in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. GAAP establishes a three-level fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs used to measure fair value. This hierarchy requires entities to maximize the use of observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs. The three levels of inputs used to measure fair value are as follows:
  - Level 1: Observable inputs such as quoted prices in active markets;
  - Level 2: Inputs, other than the quoted prices in active markets, that are observable either directly or indirectly; and
  - Level 3: Unobservable inputs in which there is little or no market data, which require the reporting entity to develop its own assumptions.

The Organization has determined that the only material financial assets or liabilities that are measured at fair value on a recurring basis and categorized using the fair value hierarchy are investments. Investments are made up of equity securities. These investments are valued using quoted market prices for similar assets. All investments at December 31, 2021 are measured at Level 1 inputs. Significant transfers between fair levels are determined at the end of the reporting period. There were no significant transfers in 2021.

**6. PAYCHECK PROTECTION PROGRAM**: In 2021, the Organization received loan proceeds in the amount of \$35,100 under the second round of the Paycheck Protection Program (the "PPP"). The PPP was established as part of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Securities Act (the "CARES Act").

The loan is payable over two years at an interest rate of 1.0%, and payment is deferred. Under the terms of the PPP, the loan is forgivable if the proceeds are used for qualifying expenses as described in the CARES Act, including payroll, benefits, rent, and utilities. As the Organization has used for loan proceeds for qualifying expenses and has applied for forgiveness of the loan, the original proceeds are recognized in contributions and grants on the statement of activities.

**7. SUBSEQUENT EVENTS:** In March 2020, the World Health Organization declared the outbreak of a novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19) as a global pandemic. COVID-19 is having notable impacts on general economic conditions in the United States and internationally. The impacts of COVID-19 on the Organization's operations and the financial results subsequent to December 31, 2021 are not available as of the date of this report.

The Organization evaluates events and transactions occurring subsequently to the date of the financial statements for matters requiring recognition or disclosure in the financial statements. The accompanying financial statements considering events through November 22, 2022, the date on which the financial statements were available to be issued.

## THE PRESBYTERY OF THE MIAMI VALLEY 2023 PROPOSED BUDGET EXPLANATORY COMMENTS NOVEMBER 12, 2022

#### **Background:**


The 2023 PMV budget reflects the work being done to more fully live into our mission to Prepare, Equip, Nurture, and Connect congregations in their ministries for God's mission. The 2023 budget also represents the challenge of being the Church of Jesus Christ in a time of declining resources, a (hopefully) waning pandemic, and layers of upheaval on social and political levels.

Before we look to 2023, we should reflect on activities of 2022. Three properties were sold resulting in nearly \$1M of one-time revenue to the Presbytery. The Presbytery office moved to Sugarcreek Presbyterian after the sale of Dayton Memorial. Two other churches were also sold, as detailed below.

The Trustees and Leadership Council have chosen to place 75% of the proceeds (\$688K) into our invested funds, reserving 25% (\$229K) for a Board Restricted fund for a more immediate impact Presbytery program (to be determined in 2023).

The impact of this activity on our invested funds is significant:



Withdrawals from our invested funds make up the gap from the connectional giving from the churches in our Presbytery and the total expenditures each year.

The proposed 2023 budget anticipates a draw \$127,074 (6.6%) of the current value (September 30<sup>th</sup>) of our invested funds shown above. For perspective here is the recent withdrawal rate from our invested funds:

We are grateful for those reserves which remind us of the faithfulness of God in providing us with resources to move courageously into an unknown future. We are confident that God is still moving among us and through us. In 2023 we expect to see the ways in which God will surprise us, doing far more than we could ever imagine.

#### **Revenues:**

1. As the total number of active members in the presbytery declines (6,640 at the end of 2021 as reported in the Annual Statistical Report), so too does the anticipated revenue from **Presbytery Connectional Support.** This decline in active members has averaged 4% per year for the last four years; membership was formerly 7,803. Historically, congregations within the Presbytery contributed about 85% the total amount apportioned in Connectional Support. Presbytery and Synod per capita rates are unchanged from 2022. General Assembly per capita rates increased by 10%.

As stated above, we have historically received an average of 85% of the calculated amount from our member churches. This drives two important budget calculations. First is a reduction in our expected Presbytery Connectional giving due to the decline in membership.

The presbytery has committed for many years to pay the full amount to General Assembly and Synod as a sign of our relationship to the councils of the Church. In other words, PMV reaches into invested funds to make Synod and GA "whole" for any shrinkage from our member churches. For 2023, this amount is \$13,048, see below.

2. Since operating expenses are expected to exceed operating revenues, the \$136,574 draw from our invested fund is 7.1% of the value \$1,915,903 of our invested funds. We are benefitting from the sale of the three church buildings in 2022. As noted above, an Invested Funds Policy is being developed to allow prospective budgeting for the use of Invested Funds, instead of the recent habit of collecting proposed expenditures from committees and balancing the budget with a draw on the invested funds.

#### **Expenditures:**

1. The Leadership Council has approved a 5% increase in total compensation for the Executive Presbyter and Stated Clerk for 2023. The table below summarizes recent changes in compensation compared to inflation from the US Department of Labor:

Increases for Bookkeeper and IT/Communications position will also be 5% for 2023. The Treasurer is a volunteer, unpaid position.

- 4. New Line item 501.400 Financial Consultant (\$10,000) represents two new items. We are continuing a relationship with BDB Group, LLC (Brent Byerly) to develop financial processes and procedures. We also anticipate continuing to use Realm ACS consultants for specific questions in our accounting system.
- 5. Line item 501.401 reduces slightly for 2023 as we will conduct our policy requires alternating Audit (2022) and Review (2023).
- 6. As described above in Revenue #1, Line item 501.455 (\$13,048) varies based on the amount of per capita actually received from congregations. Some PMV congregations do not pay the full per capita amounts, yet the presbytery has committed for many years to pay the full amount to General Assembly and Synod as a sign of our relationship to the councils of the Church. This line represents our estimate of the shortfall in congregational per capita giving in 2022. We strongly encourage every congregation to meet its entire per capita responsibilities, since not doing so serves to deplete the presbytery's reserves.

#### Staff Support Committee of the Presbytery of the Miami Valley

**Reviews.** 'Tis the season for reviews. The Staff Support Committee continued to work diligently on a summary of the 2022 review of our Executive Presbytery (EP), the Rev. Terry Kukuk. A two page summary was prepared and shared with the Leadership Council at their October meeting. Attached to the summary were the nearly thirty responses from members of Presbytery on a set of questions based on the EP's position description. The reviews are overwhelmingly positive.

The unanimous recommendation to the Leadership Council from the Staff Support Committee was that the contract for our Executive Presbytery, Terry Kukuk, be renewed for an additional 5 years.

Throughout October, November and December, members of the committee will meet with each additional member of the Presbytery staff for annual reviews.

**Budgeting.** The committee gathered for a special meeting to discuss 2023 salary recommendations for the Presbytery staff. These salary recommendations as well as the office budget recommendations were then sent onto the Trustees for review and inclusion in the 2023 budget.

**Operations.** A team of Presbytery staff, including Rev. Kukuk, Rev. Lynn Bova (Stated Clerk), John Ey and Kat Millhouse continue to work with Brent Bylerly on clarifying and improving financial practices and procedures.

**Policy and Practice.** At our November meeting, the committee will be focusing on updating and revising practices in the SSC Policy and Practice document to align with current best practices.

With thanksgiving, the Staff Support Committee welcomed a new member. Elected at the September meeting of Presbytery to serve on the committee was Cynthia Nowka. Cynthia's insight and experience in human resources will certainly elevate our vital work of supporting, encouraging and strengthening the staff of the presbytery.
