## Congregation History:

Xenia has been the home of one or more Presbyterian churches where all have actively proclaimed the eternal message of God's Love as manifested in His Son, Jesus Christ. For 180 years, the Xenia community has been richly blessed, both in ministry and supportive mission, by the Presbyterian presence.

The history of Presbyterian Churches in Xenia, Ohio began with the incorporation of the First Associate Reformed Church of Xenia in 1810 and the Xenia Associate Presbyterian Church in 1811. In 1858 the Associate Reformed and Associate Presbyterian denominations joined to become the United Presbyterian Church. At that time, the Xenia churches became First United Presbyterian and Second United Presbyterian. In 1958 they became sister churches with Xenia's Westminster Presbyterian Church when the United Presbyterian Church merged with the Presbyterian Church of the U.S.A. As a point of history, Xenia's First Presbyterian Church was renamed Westminster Presbyterian prior to relocating from Market Street to the newly constructed Springfield Pike facility in 1966. In 2021, Xenia's Westminster Presbyterian Church merged with Xenia's Memorial Presbyterian Church to form the Xenia United Presbyterian Church.
