Statement of Faith Greg Menssen

I believe in the triune God: The Father who is, Parent, Creator and the Son who is, Savior, Teacher, Friend, and the Holy Spirit who is, Blessed Presence, Inspirer. I believe that although the Trinity is three distinct persons, that God is one in essence and in spirit. I believe in the sovereign nature of God.
