Matt Aragon-Bruce (Lake Michigan Presbytery) begins as the <u>Director of the Cultivating the Gift of Preaching Initiative</u> on January 8, 2024. In this position, he will guide the implementation of the \$1.25 million grant that we received from the Lilly Endowment's Compelling Preaching grant program. A systematic theologian by training, Matt has taught at several colleges and seminaries and is the theologian-in-residence at First Presbyterian Church of Grand Haven (MI). Matt earned a MDiv and a PhD (in the history of doctrine) from Princeton Theological Seminary, and an MTh from the University of Edinburgh. He is a candidate for ordination in the Presbytery of Lake Michigan. Matt is married to the Rev. Kristine Aragon Bruce, who serves as the Associate pastor at First Pres. Grand Haven.
