

**Report from the Administrative Commission
for St. Luke United Presbyterian Church
to the Presbytery of the Miami Valley
September 8, 2026**

On May 12, 2026, the Administrative Commission reported to Presbytery that St. Luke United Presbyterian Church remained in a season of discernment regarding its future, following Rev. Dick Sedgwick's retirement and a congregational meeting held on April 12th.

The congregation continues to hold its discernment prayerfully and honestly. The session remains hopeful that the church may be able to remain in ministry through at least the end of this year. That said, the session maintains a close eye on the congregation's energy, finances and overall sustainability while prayerfully listening for the movement of the Holy Spirit.

The Worship Committee continues to oversee pulpit supply from week to week. Rev. Marc van Bulck, co-chair of the Administrative Commission, serves as moderator of the session. CRE Gidget Collins also represents the Committee on Ministry.
